

## Employment Posting – Stage Manager

This engagement is a co-production between Pacific Opera Victoria (POV) and Vancouver Opera (VOA). The VOA-CAEA Agreement – VOIS – will apply for this tour.

Contract Dates: March 8 – May 16, 2027 (Potential Holdover to May 30, 2027)

The ideal candidate will have a collaborative spirit, possess problem-solving skills under pressure, and be a true leader. Applicants should have confidence in stage management systems, be proficient in reading music, and demonstrate key leadership and organizational skills. Applicants should have experience working in opera or musical theatre, and be a team player who demonstrates a keen interest in building positive relationships with artists, production and music staff.

The company, including the stage manager, will be expected to assist with take-in, set-up, strike, and take-out.

Preference will be given to those holding an OFA Basic First Aid certificate and with a valid Driver's License with a willingness to pursue a Class 4 Driver's License.
